BlackRock TCP Capital Corp. (1) Overview

TCPC

- Business development company (BDC)
- Trades on NASDAQ: "TCPC"
- Expects to distribute most of its earnings as dividends⁽²⁾
- 9.7% current dividend yield⁽³⁾

Investment Objective

We seek to generate high total returns through current income and capital appreciation, with an emphasis on principal protection

Leveraged Loans

Focused on direct origination of senior secured loans to stable middle-market borrowers:

- Contractual first claim ahead of subordinated debt and equity
- Assets pledged as collateral
- Interest payments typically floating rate

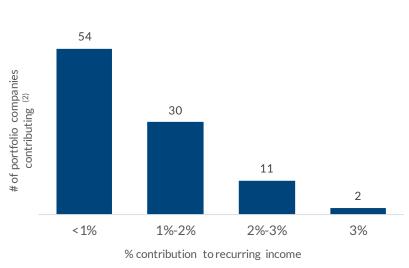

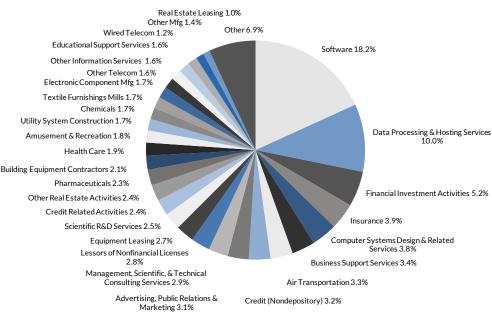
- \$1.6 billion portfolio fair value

Industry Diversification

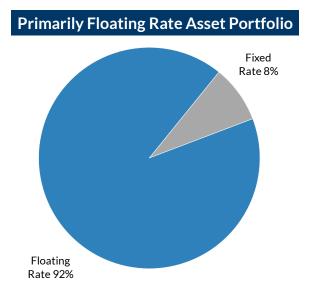


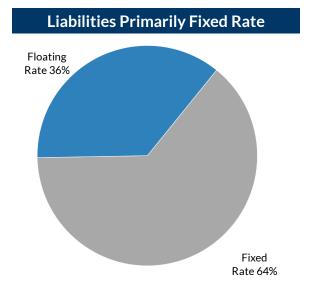

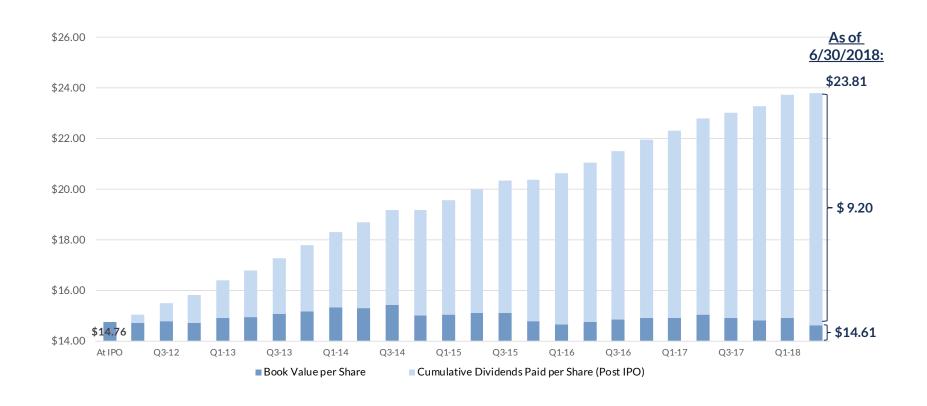

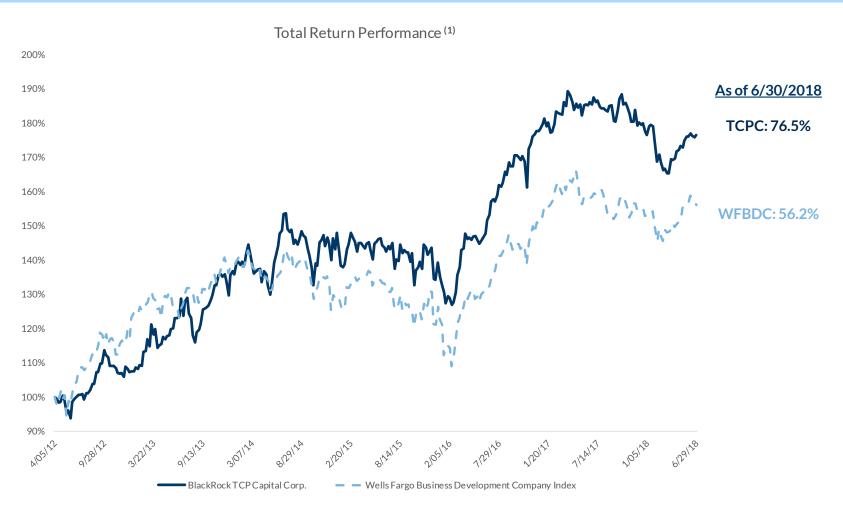
Book Value per Share and Dividends Paid

Summary of Advisor's Transaction with BlackRock
